RULES, REGULATIONS etc.

This show is **OPEN TO ALL**. The show is run by North East Riding Club (Scotland), you do not have to be a member of NERC in order to take part.

This is a show for having a go and getting “your beastie” in the ring for the first time in 2008, or ever!

This show is run under BRC rules except as stated below:

The Organisers reserve the right to (a) cancel any class (b) divide or amalgamate any class (c) alter the advertised times (d) refuse any entry without giving any reason.

Officials must be obeyed at all times. Abuse of officials, including verbal abuse, will not be tolerated and may result in elimination/disqualification.

Hats must conform to EN1384, PAS 015 or higher and must be worn and fastened **at all times when mounted**. Failure to do so will result in elimination. If competitors wish to wear a hat which does not conform to this rule (eg Beagler or bowler), they must report to the Secretary on arrival and sign a disclaimer form.

AGES FOR RIDERS OF STALLIONS. Riders must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed M & M stallions ie Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Riders must be 14 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed M & M stallions ie Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

DISCLAIMER

It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure they are in plenty of time for their class.

You can check the NERC website (www.nerc.btinternet.co.uk) to see how many entries there are at the close of entries in the classes preceding yours to gauge when your class is likely to start.

SECTION 1: COMPETITION HORSE/PONY

- Class 1 **COMPETITION/DRESSAGE HORSE** 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms, rider any age. May be ridden in snaffle or double bridle.
- Class 2 **COMPETITION/DRESSAGE PONY** 4 years old not exceeding 148cms, riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January 2008. May be ridden in snaffle or double bridle.
- Class 3 **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND COMPETITION/DRESSAGE HORSE/PONY** 4 years old, rider any age. May be ridden in snaffle or double bridle.

Method of Judging for Classes 1-3:

Phase I – 60 marks

Horses/ponies to enter the ring individually and will not be ridden by judge. Competitors will undertake an individual freestyle show to include the following:

Halt, walk on a long rein, trot serpentine, medium trot, canter with change of lead through trot. Show not to exceed 2 minutes.

Phase II – 40 marks

Once all competitors have completed Phase I, horses/ponies to be stripped and judged individually for confirmation, type and suitability for dressage.

SECTION 2: RIDDEN HORSE CLASSES

(excluding M&M)

- Class 4 **OPEN RIDDEN HORSE**, born in or before 2004, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 158cm. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.
- Class 5 **OPEN RIDDEN HORSE**, born in or before 2004, exceeding 158cm. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.
- Class 6 **COLOURED HORSE**, skewbald or piebald, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm. Rider any age. The Judge will NOT ride any exhibit in this class. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.

RIDDEN HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

open to 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 4 - 6

SECTION 3: RIDDEN PONY CLASSES

(excluding M&M)

- Class 7 **OPEN RIDDEN PONY**, born in or before 2004, exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 148cm. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.
- Class 8 **OPEN RIDDEN PONY**, born in or before 2004, not exceeding 133cm. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.
- Class 9 **COLOURED PONY**, skewbald or piebald, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 148cm. Rider any age. The Judge will NOT ride any exhibit in this class. May be shown in snaffle bridle. Competitors will be required to do a show. Class will be judged on suitability of horse for its type, conformation, manners and condition.

RIDDEN PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

SECTION 4: RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

- Class 10 **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS**, including Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- Class 11 **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS**, including Connemara, Dales, Fells, Welsh C and D, New Forest. Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND CHAMPIONSHIP

SECTION 5: MISCELLANEOUS

- Class 12 **RIDING CLUB PONY 14.2hh AND UNDER**
Mares or geldings, born in or before 2004, to be shown under saddle, to be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip or spurs. May be required to do a small jump. Riders any age.
- Class 13 **RIDING CLUB HORSE OVER 14.2hh**
Mares or geldings, born in or before 2004, to be shown under saddle, to be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip or spurs. May be required to do a small jump.
- Class 14 **VETERAN HORSE/PONY**
Mares or geldings 17 years or over to be shown under saddle. Riders any age. Riders of horses over 22 years should wear an armband and will not be required to canter.

MISCELLANEOUS CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 12-14

SECTION 6: TINY TOTS

- Class 15 **LEAD REIN PONY (plaited)**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only.
- Class 16 **FIRST PONY (plaited)**, mares or geldings, 4 years or older, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring in walk or trot.
- Class 17 **LEAD REIN PONY (mountain & moorland type)**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only.
- Class 18 **FIRST PONY (mountain & moorland type)**, mares or geldings, 4 years or older, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring in walk or trot.

TINY TOTS CHAMPIONSHIP

SECTION 7: IN-HAND inc. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

SECTION 7 WILL COMMENCE at 12.30pm in the outside arena.

- Class 19 **OPEN IN-HAND (excluding pure-bred Mountain & Moorland)** Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2007, 2006 or 2005. Class may be split by height (ie to exceed 14.2hh or not) if sufficient entries.
- Class 20 **VETERAN IN-HAND** Mares or geldings of any height and breed 17 years or over.
- Class 21 **SMALL MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN-HAND** (including Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B) Colts, fillies or geldings born in or before 2004.
- Class 22 **SMALL MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN-HAND** (including Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B) Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2007, 2006 or 2005.
- Class 23 **LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN-HAND** (including Fell, Dale, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh C & D) Colts, fillies or geldings born in or before 2004.
- Class 24 **LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN-HAND** (including Fell, Dale, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh C & D) Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2007, 2006 or 2005.

Classes 22 and 24 may be split by age or breed if there are sufficient entries

DIRECTIONS

Fountain Equestrian Centre is situated on the A947 Aberdeen to Oldmeldrum road, c.5 miles North of Aberdeen. Heading North on the A947, after the conurbation of Dyce, you will drive under an old railway bridge.

Fountain EC is on the left, about ½ mile North of this bridge.

The entrance will be sign posted with NERC signs.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY
